## Pray for Loveland Habitat

- For those in our area who are in need of decent, affordable housing.
- For the individuals & families we serve as they are going through the process of becoming homeowners.

## Volunteer – Groups or Individuals

- Work at our construction site—rain or shine during all seasons. Indoor projects are available. No experience necessary!
- Volunteer at the Loveland ReStore. **\*This is a great opportunity for YOUTH GROUPS.** Minimum age: 15.
- Join a committee. Habitat has several committees dedicated to specific needs and projects (ex: Homeowner Selection, Fundraising, Board of Directors, etc).

## Become a Financial Partner for the 2019 Faith Build House - Goal: \$20,000

- Hold a special offering for Habitat.
- Donate through your outreach or missions committee.
- Organize fundraisers: bake sales, garage sales, benefit concerts, 5k walk/runs, local restaurant fundraisers, etc.

## Invite a Habitat Representative to Speak at Your Congregation

- Staff and Homeowner to come and speak in front of your congregation during worship services.
- Information table setup in the lobby for Q&A.
- Available for Sunday school or education classes for deeper engagement.

## Sponsor a Homeowner Event

- We often need groups to provide volunteers and baked goods to “sponsor” our homeowner events: Ground-breaking ceremonies and New Home Dedications. We have roughly 10-12 of these events per year.

## Host Out of Town Volunteers

- Out of town groups often come to Loveland to volunteer - such as college groups on their spring break or AmeriCorps teams. If your building has available rooms and showers, this could be a great way to serve Habitat’s mission!

## Provide a Meal for a Volunteer Group

- Typical group build days are Friday and Saturday, year-round.

## Join the Faith Relations Committee

- The Faith Relations Committee is made up of members of local faith communities who are passionate about Habitat.
- This committee meets as needed to bridge the gap between Loveland Habitat and faith communities.
- If you want to be the “champion” of the Habitat cause at your congregation, this is for you!
